

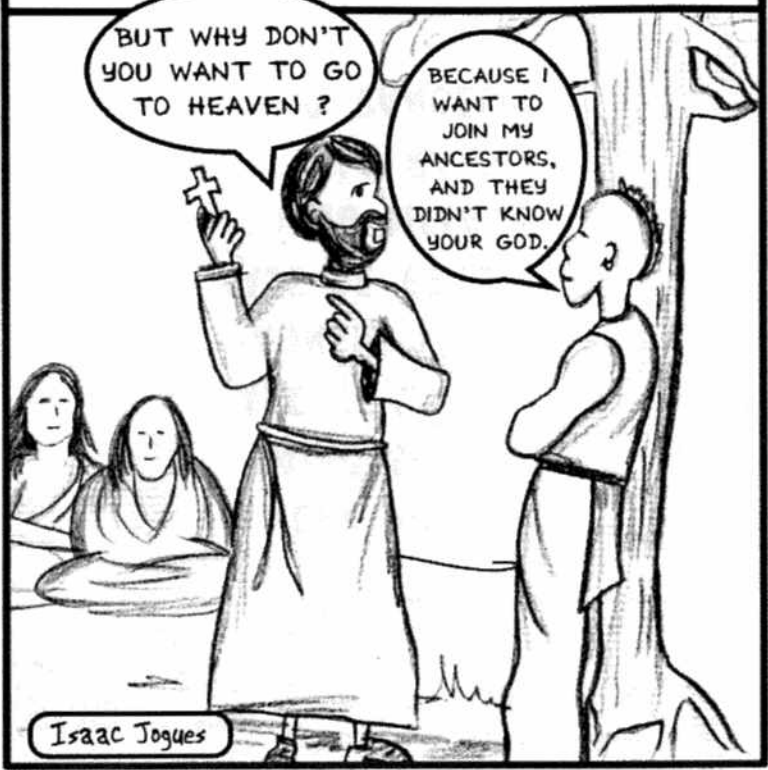

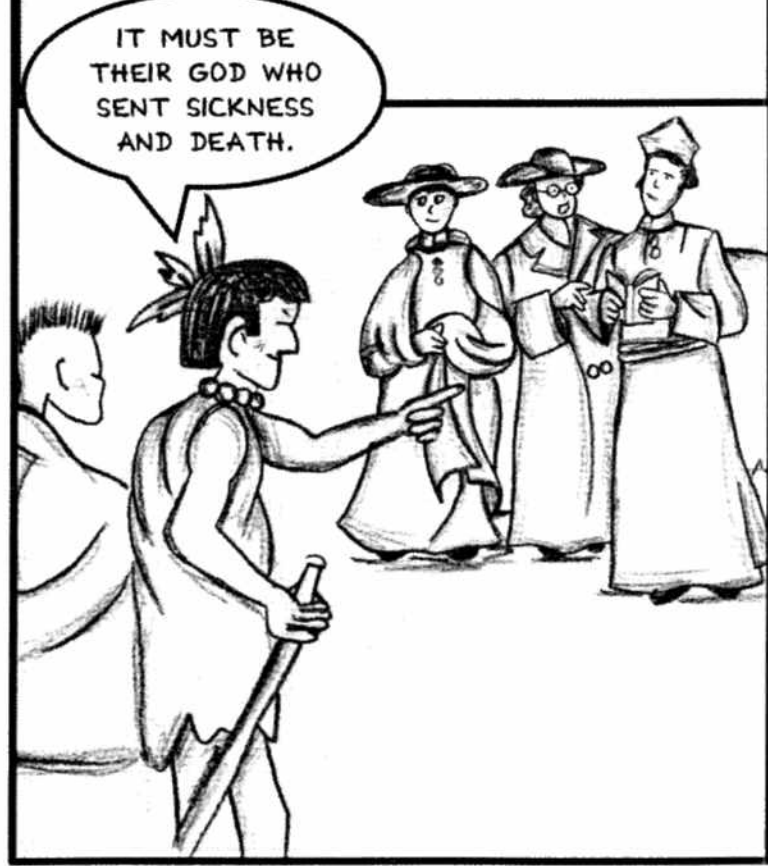

8 ANTOINE DANIEL FINDS A WAY TO REACH THE CHILDREN.



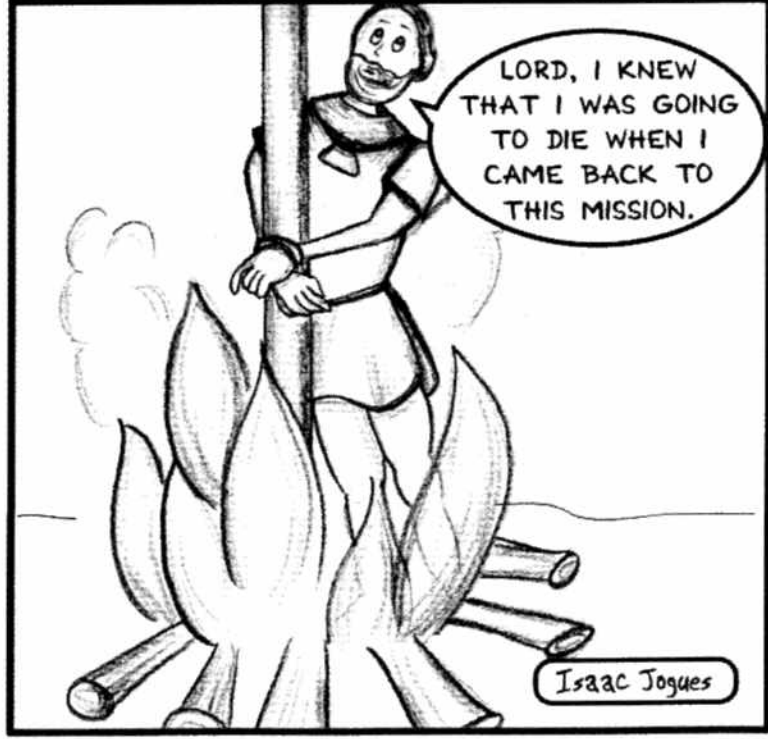
9 WITH THE ARRIVAL OF THE FRENCH, DISEASES SWEEP THROUGH THE COUNTRY.
