

Acceptance, Management and Use of Donations

Dear donors, the Archdiocese of Saint Boniface sincerely thanks you for your support of its works. We also wish to make some clarifications regarding the acceptance, management and use of your donations.

- 100% of every donation is used to support the cause designated by the donor. If, for one reason or another, it is no longer possible to support the cause that you have designated, we will do our best, within reason, to contact you and discuss how to best redirect your gift.
- We wish to express our gratitude towards our donors by thanking them and recognizing them appropriately. However, we understand that some of you prefer to remain anonymous and we are committed to respecting your wishes in this regard.
- We ensure that your personal information is managed confidentially and with care, in accordance with legal regulations. Furthermore, please note that we do not share our list of donors with any other organization.
- You may request to have your name removed from our mailing list at any point in time.
- You may revoke your authorization for direct debit and credit card payments for monthly gifts at any point in time, providing that a 30-day notice is given.
- We accept various types of donations: cash, marketable securities, and bequests, to name a few. However, we may not be able to accept a gift if, for example, it is not in keeping with the mission and values of our Church. In these cases, the Diocesan Finance Council of the Archdiocese of Saint Boniface would make the decision not to accept the gift.
