Ed Krupica Scholarship Application

Training in The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is essential for all adults who desire to serve children as CGS catechists and thus the Board of CGSAC established the Ed Krupica Scholarship Fund in 2007 in recognition of the service Ed Krupica offered to CGS in Canada while Director of Religious Education for the Hamilton Roman Catholic Diocese.

Ed believes, as does the CGSAC board, that lack of personal financial resources should not be a barrier to CGS training. Thus, through the Ed Krupica Scholarship Fund financial assistance is available for CGSAC members.

The Edward Krupica Scholarship Fund Advisory Board will evaluate all applications for all scholarships. Scholarships will be granted based on the relative degree of financial need and a commitment by the recipient to serve in the work of CGSAC.

A completed Ed Krupica scholarship application includes:

1) A short description of:

- Your learning objectives;
- How you plan to use your learning experience following completion of your training;
- Where and whom will you serve following completion of the course;
- Why the training, for which you are requesting a scholarship, is important.
- A short statement of your current financial situation
- Your community's demographic and financial situation.

2) A completed Application Form (found on next page)

NOTE: It is expected that you will first seek local support from the community you will serve. Generally scholarships are only funded to cover tuition of courses or workshops. Travel/accommodation costs will not be covered by scholarships.

Eligibility for funding requires the following:

- Applicant must hold or take out a membership in CGSAC;
- Requests must be made at least 30 days prior to course or workshop*;
- Course must be under the auspices of either CGSAC or CGSUSA
- Applications must be 'complete as received' to be considered
