## INFORMATION for PROSPECTIVE CANDIDATES

**NATHANAEL 2019-2022...a new group** begins in September 2019 and will run once a month, 10 months of the year, on Saturdays and Sundays, (not live-in) until June 2022. The program will be held in the Parish Hall of the St. Boniface Cathedral. The 2019-2020 Calendar is in your info kit.

### Themes:

- Year **1**: Personal Conversion
- Year **2**: Called to be Church
- Year **3**: Sent into the World

### Five main pillars:

1. Personal Growth
2. Spiritual Life and Prayer
3. Scripture
4. Church Tradition
5. Missionary Disciples

The Church Tradition pillar includes the study of Vatican II documents, marriage and the family and pastoral responses to current major ethical questions. The Missionary Disciples' pillar will address the topics of new evangelization, Christian leadership and social justice.

Two to three hours per pillar per month, on the average.

The Eucharist, celebration of the Sacraments and Morning and Evening Prayer will be interwoven into this process and will follow the Liturgical Year.

Candidates will be required to attend all weekend sessions every month.

**What to do next:**

1. Fill in the *Request for Interview* form.  
Forms are available at your parish, online, and at the *Come & See* Sessions. Obtain your Pastor's or Parish Life Director's signature. **Please note that the deadline for application is March 31, 2019.**
2. Two members of the Nathanael Formation Team will interview each applicant.
3. Applicants and Pastors and Parish Life Directors will receive confirmation of acceptance by June 30, 2019.

The purpose of Nathanael is to help each candidate deepen his or her baptismal vocation to become a missionary disciple in our world today.

In the past, several candidates became leaders in their Christian communities. Many also chose to become witnesses of the Gospel among the poor and the neglected, and in the world in which we live.
