# \*REMINDER\* Pontifical Collection for the Church in the Holy Land on Good Friday – April 18 2025

The Good Friday collection, established fifty years ago by Pope Paul VI and promoted by the Holy See ever since, is the only annual request that the Holy See asks of dioceses and parishioners throughout the world. It helps the Church in the Holy Land to maintain the Christian sites that are so important to Christians all over the world, and to provide pastoral, educational and social works among the small Christian population.

The collection was a response to the needs of the Church throughout the Holy Land. At the time, the Church there was suffering persecution, unable to look after itself and losing the presence of Christians who wanted to avoid such hardship. Over time, and especially in recent years, this appalling situation has worsened. The Church and our Christian brothers and sisters are counting on your help to maintain a faithful Christian presence in the land of our Lord. Please give generously during Good Friday celebrations.

#### \*Carlo Acutis, do you know who he is?

This young Italian (1991-2006) was considered a "computer geek" but his passion was for God and the Eucharist. He used his computer skills and internet savvy to develop a website exhibition on Eucharistic miracles hoping that it would help people to realize that Jesus is really present in the Eucharist and come back to Mass. *Click on the link:* Carlo Acutis (Eucharistic Miracles' Exhibition. At the age of 15 (2006) Carlo died of acute leukemia. The call for Acutis to be beatified began not long after his death. Carlo Acutis will be canonized a 'Saint' in Rome, by Pope Francis, during the *Jubilee of Teenagers* 

from April 25-27, 2025.



#### \*NEW\* Bishops raise serious concerns about threats to charitable status designation

On Monday, 10 March 2025, the members of the Permanent Council of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) expressed their grave concern regarding two recommendations made by the House of Commons Standing Committee on Finance within *Report 21: Pre-Budget Consultations in Advance of the 2025 Budget*. These recommendations (#429 and #430), if adopted, would be profoundly detrimental to Canada's charitable sector, because they would:

- Revoke the charitable status of "anti-abortion organizations" (#429);
- Amend the *Income Tax Act* such that "the advancement of religion" would no longer qualify as a legitimate purpose for granting charitable status. (#430)

After consulting widely, including with experts in charity law, the members of the Permanent Council sent a letter to the Hon. Dominic LeBlanc, Minister of Finance, defending the value and role of faith-based charities for Canadian society, as well as the unfairness of targeting pro-life organizations. They urged the government to abandon the two recommendations and to conduct comprehensive consultations within the charitable sector before embarking on any legislative changes that could threaten the viability of charitable organizations and adversely affect the millions of Canadians who depend on them for essential services and support.
