

DR 16 Divine Renovation Conference

1. Forming & Communicating Vision

- A picture of the future that produces passion in us
 - written down
 - where we are going
 - communicated with passion to light the fire
 - look "outside the box" and be passionate about the future







2. Leading out of a Team

- a pastor cannot be the only leader
- co-responsibility
- do not rely only on title/office/authority
- learning to grow, learn and adapt







3. Preaching

- visioning homily at all Sunday Masses every 3 weeks
- change has to be explained & tied to vision inviting parishioners to dream the dream.
 - explain "what" and "how"
 - where we are going?
 - text-free, use audio visual
 - communicate with passion








4. Championing Evangelization

- Centre pastoral activities on evangelization (for both existing parishioners and those not-yet members)
- Starts with forming "missionary disciples" who will be sent to make disciples of others (bearing fruit)







5. Money, Money, Money

- don't worry about money: as the community grows spiritually, it will also grow financially
- Banish all fundraising
- encourage tithing

- Is your experience ordinary or extraordinary?








MUSIC MATTERS

- Every mass ideally has some praise & petition music








DEVELOPING YOUR DR CREWS

- Ministry Leader Handbook
- Good artists copy. Great artists steal
 DANGEROUS ASSUMPTION:
- DANGEROUS ASSUMPTION:
 Everything is fine as it is so we just make a few minor tweaks
- First, bring people to Jesus
- Delegate authority rather than tasks
- Don't use people to build your church; use your Church to build people
- Great leaders are servants
- Are you training apprentices?

- Should analyze:
 - Belonging (Engagement)
 - Believing (Spiritual commitment)
 - Becoming (Discipleship formation)

Engagement is not what I do in my parish. It is how I feel about my parish.

•Tend to analyze:

- •Attendance (outcome)
- •Giving (outcome)
- Registration (outcome)







ENGAGEMENT

What causes people to become engaged?

• What do I get (something valuable from belonging to this faith community)?

• What can I give (valuable contribution to the success of the faith community)?

- **Do I belong** (Am I valued)?
- How can I grow (human desire to learn & grow intellectually, emotionally & spiritually)?




